Lori Wick and Janette Oke both write Historical Inspirational Romances. So if you love Lori Wick you may want to try Janette Oke or vice versa. For those of you have already tried both, here are a few authors and novels you might like to read.

Linda Chaikin writes Historical fiction whose characters must overcome the odds of their journeys to love.

Lori Copeland writes the Brides of the West series. Each book is about different Callahan sisters, who sign up to become mail-order brides.

Ruth Glover offers short novels of life and love on the Canadian frontier that is a natural choice for those who like the Oke's prairie romance. Try Glover's Saskatchewan Saga.

Leisha Kelly Wotham, like Oke writes in a rural setting. Kelly sets her stories in rural Illinois during the Great Depression. Try Kelly's Wortham Family Series.

Catherine Palmer writes Inspirational Romances set in a variety of historical locals. For stories set in the West, try *Prairie Rose* or *English Ivy*.

Tracie Peterson is a Christian writer who focuses heavily on religious content. For her Inspirational stories of the West try Peterson's Heirs of Montana Series

Eugenia Price's novels were not originally written for the Christian market; however, she writes in the same style as Oke and the content fits in with the Christian market. Try Price's St. Simon's Island Trilogy.

Francine Rivers writes Historical Fiction that features well-known and not-so-well known characters from the bible. Try Rivers' *The Scarlet Thread*.
